## *Methodology:*

This poll was conducted between March 17-March 17, 2023 among a sample of 1000 Adults. The interviews were conducted online and the data were weighted to approximate a target sample of Adults based on gender, educational attainment, region, and age. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of plus or minus 3 percentage points.
